# **Important Information for Applicants**

## What is this document for?

## This document includes two separate application forms:

## **\*** Form 1 – BNTAC Membership Application

- Use this form to apply to become a member of BNTAC. If you are accepted as a BNTAC member, you will also be on the register of Banjima Common Law Holders.
- Becoming a member means you can participate in the governance of BNTAC, including attending, speaking and voting at general meetings.

## **\*** Form 2 – Application for Register of Banjima Beneficiaries (BMS)

- This form relates to the Banjima Benefits Management Structure (BMS).
- By completing this form, you are applying to the BMS Trustee to be included on the Register of Banjima Beneficiaries.
- This is separate to your application for BNTAC membership.

## Why are there two forms?

These forms are for different purposes:

- The **BNTAC Membership Application** is about your connection to Banjima and your request to be accepted as a Common Law Holder and member of BNTAC.
- The **Register of Banjima Beneficiaries form** is about your eligibility to access trust benefits under the Banjima BMS. If you currently or previously received benefits from another group, you may not be eligible to receive benefits from the Banjima BMS.

## Respect is central to this process

Applicants may intend to engage with Elders and other knowledgeable Banjima persons when gathering genealogical and cultural information to support their application.

- Please approach Elders with courtesy and respect. Elders have deep knowledge of Banjima culture their time and input are valuable and must be respected.
- Do not engage in any intimidating or coercive behaviour if you have discussions with Banjima persons about your application.
- For privacy reasons, the BNTAC Office cannot provide contact details for Elders.
